



When Mark Hix and Mitch Tonks visited Quinta de la Rosa in June 2009 they discovered some delicious white wines. They were most impressed by one of the blends which they found to be an ideal match for seafood and fish. After an evening of brainstorming, they came up with a name for the wine - TONNIX - a play on the two chef's names. Mark's great friend, the artist, Tracey Emin was asked to design a label capturing the whole story. Mark Hix was Executive chef for the Ivy, Caprice and Scotts for many years, he now owns and runs his own restaurants London and Lyme Regis. Mitch Tonks runs his own two seafood restaurants in South England. The wine has been so popular that its first run of 600 bottles sold out in the first month of release.
